

LITERARY TRADE SHOW CONTRACT—ARTIST VENDORS
8th Annual Dahlonega Literary Festival
November 12 & 13, 2011

1. The Literary Trade show will be located in Hancock Park in downtown Dahlonega. Hours of event are:
Saturday, November 12: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
Sunday, November 13: 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
Tents may not be erected before 6 p.m. on Friday, November 11 and may not be taken down prior to 2 p.m. on Sunday, November 13.
2. You must supply your own tent or canopy, not to exceed 10' x 10'. A specific color canvas is not required.
3. You will be assigned a site number and you must use that site.
4. This is an outdoor area – the event will be held rain or shine and you will need to make any provisions in the event of inclement weather.
5. No questionable or inappropriate material may be displayed or sold. The committee reserves the right to deny vending rights to any applicant, with or without cause, at the Committee's sole discretion, up to and throughout the Festival.
6. We cannot guarantee security for items left overnight in the vending area. It would be to your interest to remove materials from your canopy overnight. The canopy or tent may remain.
7. The non-refundable cost of the site for the Festival is \$50. Checks should be made payable to The Dahlonega Literary Festival and mailed to Sharon Kridel, c/o State Farm Insurance, 3043 Morrison Moore Parkway, Dahlonega, GA 30533.
8. Artist Vendor booths should reflect the "literary" nature of the festival. This could mean using books as display props, creating bookmarks to sell, literary art design, costumes, decorating your booth with a literary motif, etc. How this requirement is interpreted and executed is left to the discretion of the artist vendor. Be creative, this just needs to set the backdrop for your work.
9. One artist per booth. All goods for sale by artists shall be handmade by the artist. Absolutely NO RESALE ITEMS! No buy/sell imports, kits or commercial products. Literary Festival reserves the right to ask any artist to remove items that do not meet this guideline at the sole discretion of the Literary Festival.
10. Artist vendors must be members of the Dahlonega Arts Council. Applications can be found by going to <http://www.dahlonegaarts.org/member-information> and clicking on the Membership Brochure PDF. Artist membership is \$25 annually.
